




Teachers Spotlight!

Fun in the Sun Recipes!

Fluffy Slime Recipe!

2/3 c. White Elmers Glue
 1/2 tsp. Baking Soda
 1/4 c. Water
 2-3 c. Shaving Cream
 1.5 tablespoons Contact Lens Solution
 Important: your brand of contact lens solution must have boric acid and sodium borate in the ingredient list. This is what interacts with the glue to form the **slime.**

Unpoppable Bubbles!

Measure 6 cups of water into one container, then pour 1 cup of dish soap into the water and slowly stir it until the soap is mixed in. Try not to let foam or **bubbles** form while you stir.
 Measure 1 tablespoon of glycerin or 1/4 cup of corn syrup

DIY Sidewalk Chalk

Mix 1 cup of Plaster of Paris with 3/4 cup of water.
 Add color to your mixture using powdered tempera paint. Blend well and let stand for a few minutes.
 Pour your mixture into the molds you chose.
 Set aside and let dry completely. Once dry you can remove your chalk from the mold.
 Set it aside to dry for approximately 24
