Fluffy Slime Recipe!

2/3 c. White Elmers Glue 1/2 tsp. Baking Soda 1/4 c. Water 2-3 c. Shaving Cream 1.5 tablespoons Contact Lens Solution **Important: your brand of contact lens solution must have boric acid and sodium borate in the ingredient

list. This is what interacts with the glue to form the slime

Unpoppable Bubbles!

Measure 6 cups of water into container, then pour 1 cup of dish soap into the water and slowly stir it until the soap is mixed in. Try not to let foam or bubbles form while you stir. Measure 1 tablespoon of glycerin or 1/4 cup of corn syrup and add it to the container. Stir the solution until it is mixed together.

DIY Sidewalk Chalk

Mix 1 cup of Plaster of Paris with 3/4 cup of water. Add color to your mixture using

powdered tempera paint.
Blend well and let stand for a few minutes.

Pour your mixture into the molds you chose.

Set aside and let dry completely. Once dry you can remove your chalk from the mold.

Set it aside to dry for approximately 24 hours more.

Take your chalk outside and create fun masterpieces!
