Valentine's Day and classroom parties are quickly approaching! Classroom parties will be on Friday, February 13th around snack time!

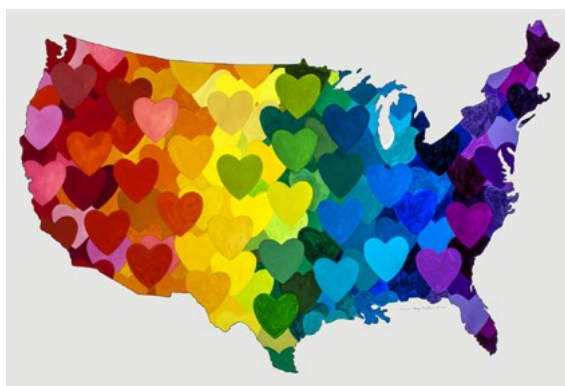
Check with your child's teacher for exact party times as well as sign up sheets for the classroom!

Pre K is participating in Hearts Across America

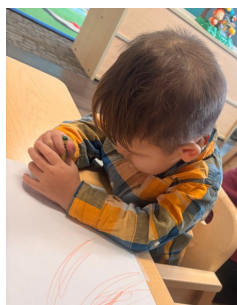
